<u>English</u>: Much of our work will be based around <u>Iron Giant by Ted Hughes</u>. We will use the books to explore the features of newspaper reports and letter writing. We will also take part in performance poetry.

<u>Maths</u>: We will be developing our knowledge of the four operations; <u>multiplication</u>, <u>division</u>, <u>addition</u> and <u>subtraction</u>. We will also be learning about <u>fractions</u>.

<u>History and Geography:</u> Our History-focused topic is the Anglo-Saxons and Scots. Our Geography-based topic this term is Spain. Our big questions will be 'What was life like after the Romans?' and 'Where in the world is Spain?'

<u>Science</u>: Our topics are <u>Animals including Humans</u> and <u>States of Matter</u>. Our big questions will be 'Do taller children jump higher?' and 'Do all materials change state when heated or cooled?'.

<u>Religion</u>: We will follow the Come and See scheme and our topics this term will be <u>Journeys</u>, <u>Listening and Sharing</u>. & <u>Giving All</u>. Year 3 will also be working towards the Sacrament of Reconciliation. <u>Confirmation of Reconciliation and First Holy Communion dates will be sent out separately</u>.
