



School Uniform Policy

At our school, we pride ourselves on our dress code and believe that doing so develops a sense of belonging. Children are required to wear school uniform and the co-operation of parents is sought in maintaining high standards of dress.

Nursery Uniform

Navy "St Bernadette's" V-necked sweatshirt <u>or</u> Navy "St Bernadette's" V-necked cardigan Pale blue polo shirt Grey skirt or pinafore Dark trousers, leggings or joggers Grey tights White or grey socks Blue and white summer dress (Summer term only) Sensible black shoes with Velcro fastening

Infant Uniform (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2)

<u>Girls</u>

Grey pinafore dress, skirt or trousers Pale blue polo shirt Navy "St Bernadette's" V-necked sweatshirt <u>or</u> Navy "St Bernadette's" V-necked cardigan Grey tights White or grey socks Blue and white summer dress (Summer term only) Sensible black shoes with Velcro fastening until your child can tie own laces/fasten own buckles (not sports branded and no boots or trainers)

<u>Boys</u>

Grey trousers / tailored shorts Pale blue polo shirt Grey or black socks Navy "St Bernadette's "V-necked sweatshirt Sensible black shoes with Velcro fastening until your child can tie own laces/fasten own buckles (not sports branded and no boots or trainers)

Junior Uniform (Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6)

<u>Girls</u>

Grey pinafore dress, skirt or trousers Navy "St Bernadette's" V-necked sweatshirt <u>or</u> Navy 'St Bernadette's' V-necked cardigan Grey tights Grey or white socks Pale blue shirt and school tie Blue and white summer dress (Summer term only) Sensible black shoes (not sports branded and no boots or trainers)

<u>Boys</u>

Grey trousers / tailored shorts Grey or black socks Navy "St Bernadette's" V-necked sweatshirt Pale blue shirt and school tie Sensible black shoes (not sports branded and no boots or trainers)

PE Uniform

From Year 1 onwards, children are required to wear the following clothing for PE and the again the co-operation of parents is sought in this. *Please note Reception children do not need a PE kit* until the Summer term.

The PE uniform consists of: Navy blue t-shirt with the school logo on Navy blue plain shorts Navy blue plain leggings White socks Plimsolls or trainers may be worn for outdoor games.

Please note - Branded sportswear or Football kits should <u>not</u> be worn

All aspects of uniform are available from the school office.

<u>PE Tracksuit</u>

We do have a School tracksuit that some children choose to wear as well as their PE kit. This optional and can be bought from JSA Print in Haslingden. They will deliver to school or you can order to your home for a small delivery fee.

Jewellery, Make-Up and Nail Varnish

- *Small plain stud earrings* and watches are the only jewellery permitted in school. Smart watches are not allowed.
- Earrings should **not** be worn for school on days when your child has PE. This is for health and safety reasons. We strongly recommend that if you wish your child to have earrings, you get their ears pierced during the summer holidays.
- Make up and nail varnish should **not** be worn to school unless for an out of school hours function, for example a school disco or a show only.

<u>Hairstyles</u>

- All hairstyles should be smart and not unnaturally structured
- Hair should be neat and tidy and not shaved too short or have tram lines in it. (e.g. No 1 or 0 cuts are not acceptable)
- Hair should not be dyed or have streaks in it
- Long hair should be tied back and away from the face Headwear must be small and discreet (large bows, large headbands etc. should not be worn)
