EYFS CURRICULUM MEETING

We will be hosting a Meet the Teacher Meeting on **Thursday 2nd October at 9am**, in the school hall. It will last approximately 45 minutes. This will give you a chance to meet the teaching staff and learn about how we will support your child in their early Years journey. Please note this meeting is for parents/carers only & is not suitable for children to attend.

WELCOME SERVICE

On **Tuesday 14th October** we will be having a "Welcome" service in Church for all Nursery & Reception children at 9am. The service will last approximately 20 minutes and is for both children and adults so please join us if you can. Instead of bringing your child to school that day, arrive at Church for 9am.

If your child is in Breakfast Club that morning, staff will walk your child over to Church for the start of the service. If any of you are able to walk back to school, after the service, your help would be much appreciated.

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SOME OTHER THINGS TO REMEMBER :

- Children should not bring any toys into school. If these get lost or broken it often causes lots of upset for your child.
- All clothing/belongings **must** be labelled - remember pen washes off. Don't forget to also label your child's shoes. We have lots of children with exactly the same pair!
- Check and empty your child's blue book bag every night and ensure that it, along with your child's journal, are brought into school every day.
- Journals - Please write messages to the teacher in here. Once your child begins to bring home reading/phonics/maths activities, it is very important that you sign the journal, each evening, to say that these tasks have been completed.
- Key-rings - Please can all children have one key-ring only on their book bag? This will help them to identify their bag easily but stop lots of them getting tangled together.
- Wellies - Please send a labelled pair of wellies into school. Place them on the outdoor rack. These are to remain in school.
- Water bottles - Send your child with a clearly labelled water bottle each day. Please note only **still water** is allowed in these bottles and not juice. Could we also ask that water bottles are not put into book bags as books are often ruined by leaks.
- Snacks - Children are provided with a healthy snack each day.
- Please be aware that children will regularly be involved in messy play. We therefore ask that you bear this in mind when choosing a school coat/dressing for non-uniform days.



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SOME OTHER THINGS TO REMEMBER :

- SEESAW- This is our online learning journal and an essential part of your child's journey in Reception. You will receive an email link in the next few weeks to set up your child's account. We will send a text to remind you to look out for it
- Jumpers/Cardigans - At the moment children may not need to wear a jumper or cardigan as it is very hot in the classroom and they can wear their coat when outside.
- Start and end of day - Reception doors open at 8:45am and our register closes at 9:00am. The end of our day is 3:20pm.
- If your child is going to attend Breakfast/After School Club, please use the main school entrance on Abingdon Ave, where a member of school staff will be there to greet you.
- If we do need to ring you, please be aware that our number may come up as no caller ID.

Finally, please remember your child may be very tired for the first few weeks as they start full days. We are busy all day long!
